## Ages of Men and Earth before and after the Flood

Here is a chart showing the ages of men and the earth before the Flood, according to the genealogy in Genesis 5:

The chart below shows the ages of men in Shem's family line after the Flood, as recorded in the 11<sup>th</sup> chapter of Genesis. Notice how quickly human life spans decreased.

If you add 2 years to Arphaxad's age, then add the ages of his descendants to Eber when he begot Peleg, you find it was about 101 years from the Flood until God confounded the languages and divided the land between the people groups that emerged:

Add that to the age of earth before the Flood, plus the one year Noah's family was in the ark, and we find the earth was 1,658 years old by the time the tower of Babel was abandoned:

$$1,556 + 1 + 101 = 1,658$$
