## Psalm 14

- <sup>1</sup> The fool has said in his heart, "*There is* no God."

  They are corrupt,

  They have done abominable works,

  There is none who does good.
- <sup>2</sup> The LORD looks down from heaven upon the children of men, To see if there are any who understand, who seek God.
- <sup>3</sup> They have all turned aside, They have together become corrupt; *There is* none who does good, No, not one.
- <sup>4</sup> Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge, Who eat up my people *as* they eat bread, And do not call on the LORD?

- <sup>2</sup> God looks down from heaven upon the children of men, To see if there are *any* who understand, who seek God.
- <sup>3</sup> Every one of them has turned aside; They have together become corrupt; *There is* none who does good, No, not one.
- <sup>4</sup> Have the workers of iniquity no knowledge, Who eat up my people *as* they eat bread, And do not call upon God?
- <sup>5</sup> There they are in great fear *Where* no fear was, For God has scattered the bones of him who encamps against you; You have put *them* to shame, Because God has despised them.
- <sup>6</sup> Oh, that the salvation of Israel would come out of Zion! When God brings back the captivity of His people, Let Jacob rejoice *and* Israel be glad.
